PaintShop Pro X3/X4

Infrared Photography

Level : Beginner

Materials : Photographs

Open the image resize to 500 pixels on the largest side x 200 ppi resolution.

Open Adjust, Hue & Saturation, Vibrancy and increase the slider to around 23.

Promote background layer and name it image 1.

Apply Negative image from Image.

Duplicate image 1 and name the new layer image 2.

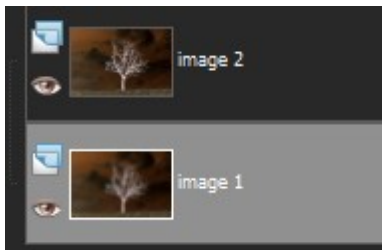


Image 1 from the top of the Layer palette, select on the Blend Mode drop down box and apply Hard Light.

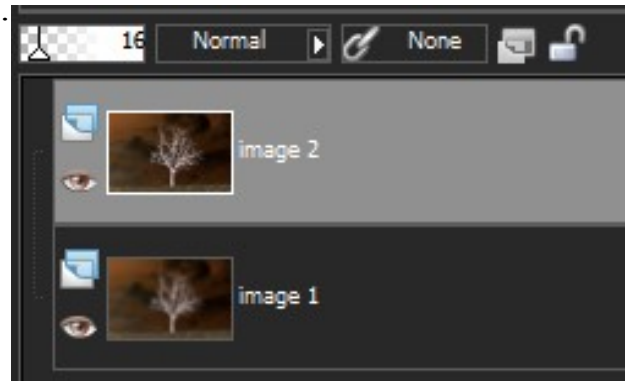
Close the eye on image 2.

Highlight image 1, and apply Gaussian Blur, 5 from Image, Blur.

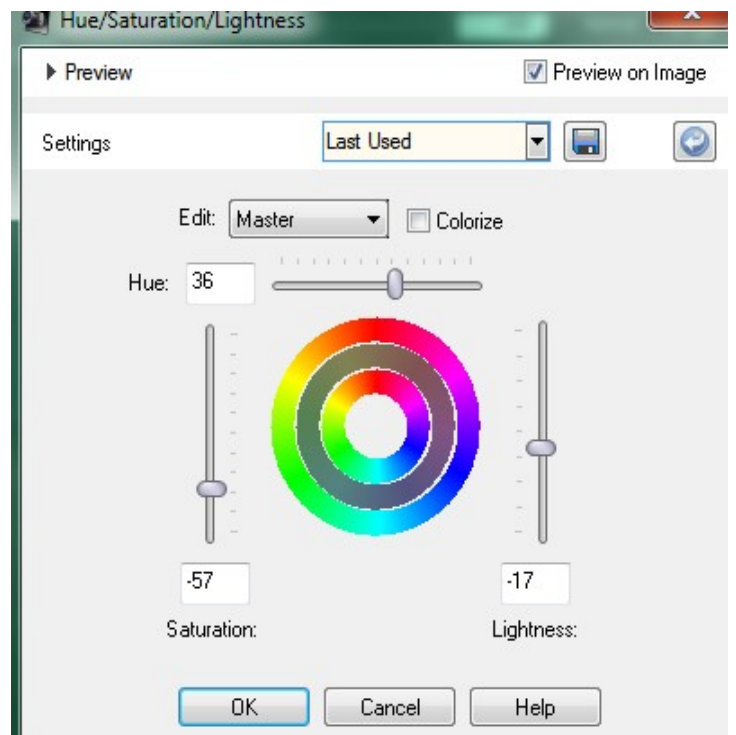


Open the eye image 2 and apply an opacity of about 16.

Merge Visible.



Apply Hue/Saturation/Lightness with the settings shown on the right. These settings give the image a green effect as shown in the image below. You can choose another HSL according to your likeness.





Another method is to apply Blend Modes and give an image a Pop Art effect.
